CONGRATULATIONS to Oneida High School Senior, Megan Dwyer, for being selected to participate in the New York State School Music Association's All-State Treble Choir!

Typically, about 1200 talented students from across the state are selected each year to travel to Rochester, NY, in early December, to spend 3 days under the direction of highly accomplished conductors from across the country. While only approximately 1200 are chosen, there are thousands who audition statewide. Their selection is based on scores they received the previous Spring on their NYSSMA solos. Due to Covid, the NYSSMA festivals did not happen in May. This year's selections were instead based on scores from the Spring of 2019, and Megan's scores earned her a spot this year!

With the current state of the health crisis in our country, the NYSSMA All-State students will NOT be able to meet in Rochester this December. Instead, Megan will have to prepare her music and submit a video recording of her individual performance, which will then be added to the many other voices selected for the Treble Chorus. All of the recordings will be professionally mastered to create a virtual choir performance of their musicl

Although Megan won't have the same experience as a typical student who would get to be a physical part of an All-State choir, this is still quite an honor to have been chosen! Students who are chosen are considered to be among THE BEST musicians in the state, and we here in Oneida are incredibly proud of her accomplishments!



To My Wonderful St. John's Family:


